# How to collect your animal's faeces

## Instructions:

1. Complete the Parasite ID Form.
2. Gather a suitable sample from your animal or wherever the parasite was found (e.g. hair plucks or skin scraps). If you are not sure how to collect the sample, please call us – we would be happy to help!
3. Put sample into a secure plastic pot or similar.
4. Place the sealed sample into an envelope along with the completed form and post 1st class on the same day\* to:
